Turf Field Use Agreement

Rules and Regulations

1. Conditions for Field Use

- A. Each Coach/Director is to know and understand all of the rules regarding use of the field. Those Coaches/Directors should make parents and participants aware of and enforce the rules and regulations.
- B. A Facility Use Form with proper insurance must be approved to practice or play. Individual coaches may request additional field time through the organization's officials.
- C. Unless indicated on the approved facility use form, field space may not be shared with other organizations.
- D. Field use is for the times specified on the approved facility use form. Organizations should not come early or leave later than specified times.
- E. Valhalla High School has first priority and therefore if an event is running late, games must finish before the next group is to use the field.
- F. Patrons should use common sense when parking. Park in marked stalls only and do not block entrances or emergency paths. Vehicles are not allowed on the field or track at any time.
- G. All equipment and adjacent facilities should only be used if agreed to in the facility use form. Respect for this equipment is expected and required.
- H. Valhalla High School is not responsible for any items that are lost or stolen.
- I. No Alcohol, Tobacco or Drugs are allowed on campus at any time.
- J. Pets are not allowed on campus and therefore not allowed on the Field or Track areas.
- K. Access to the Field/Track is limited to the Participants and the Coaches while the event is in progress.
- L. The field cannot be used in severe weather conditions involving threats of lightning. Threat should be gone for at least 30 minutes before resuming event.

2. Rules for Field Maintenance

- A. NO Gatorade or Drinks other than Water on the Field/Track.
- B. NO Sunflower Seeds on the Field/Track.
- C. NO Food of any kind on the Field/Track.
- D. NO Gum on the Field/Track.
- E. NO Glass Containers allowed on the Field/Track.
- F. NO Bikes/Scooters/Skateboards/Roller-Blades on Field/Track.
- G. NO Paint or Markings on the Field/Track.
- H. NO Stakes or Staked Umbrellas may be use on the Field/Track.
- I. NO Fireworks or Open Flames may be used on the Field/Track.
- J. NO Metal Spikes or High Heeled Shoes on the Field/Track.
- K. Field must be left in the condition that it was found. All litter/trash should be placed in trash receptacles and items brought to the field should be taken from the field.

Minimum Fine for violation of these rules is \$100.00.
